

Dear Mrs or Mss.,

with this letter, I would like to clarify, on the basis of European directives and existing legal norms, the necessity and the type of documents accompanying the construction products (and in particular those offered by Roca company).

Construction products intended for permanent installation in the buildings are placed on the market when they are fit for their intended use - they meet the essential requirements for the construction works during an economically reasonable period of operation on the premise that it is properly designed and built.

The technical and essential requirements for products within the meaning of the Buildings Directive are defined in technical specifications that are: Harmonized European Standard; European technical approved and recognized national technical specifications.

For those groups of products, for which the above documents exist, it is necessary to issue a corresponding document - Manufacturer's Declaration of Conformity based on the technical specifications, as well as affixing the CE marking..

There is a group of products, such as: bathroom accessories, urinal separators, pedestals, semi- pedestals, seat and covers, mirror and furniture for which there are no harmonized European standards and specifications, and in this sense there is no requirement as well as ground for issuing a Declaration of performance or any other document, related to any particular standard.
